# HOW CAN YOU HELP?

We're looking for YA book-related items to auction during our online event, running from **October 7-16, 2016**. Items can be anything YA or kidlit-related, including:

- SIGNED BOOKS
- SWAG LIKE BOOKMARKS, POSTCARDS, OR OTHER BOOK-RELATED GOODIES
- SERVICES LIKE QUERY LETTER EVALUATIONS OR MANUSCRIPT CRITIQUES

Bundles are also welcome and encouraged. For example, a sample bundle could include all the books in a series as well as bookmarks, pins, T-shirts or other goodies related to the series; or a collection of all of an author's published works.

## HOW WILL ITEMS BE COLLECTED?

It's up to you! Each author has the option of sending the items directly to the winning bidder (we encourage this option, as it allows for personalization) or sending pre-signed books/goodies to us to ship to the winning bidder after the auction. Our focus is on transparency and convenience for our donors!
